Council Resolution on a strategic framework for European cooperation in education and training towards the European Education Area and beyond (2021-2030)

- the personal, social and professional fulfilment of all citizens, whilst promoting democratic values, equality, social cohesion, active citizenship, and intercultural dialogue;
- sustainable economic prosperity, the green and digital transitions, and employability.

Council Recommendation on VET

- skills to support both the recovery and the green and digital transitions, while ensuring inclusiveness

European Skills Agenda

- **European pillar of social rights, sustainable development,**
- Excellence in VET (GreenDeal, Pakt for Skills)

COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION ON VET FOR SUSTAINABLE COMPETITIVENESS, SOCIAL FAIRNESS AND RESILIENCE (2020)

- to make sure VET equips young people and adults with the skills to support both the recovery and the green and digital transitions, while ensuring inclusiveness.
- **By 2025 the following EU-level objectives:**
 - the share of **employed graduates** from VET should be at least **82 %**;
 - **60 %** of recent graduates from VET benefit from exposure **to work-based learning** during their vocational education and training. **8 %** of learners in VET benefit from a **learning mobility abroad**
